Tony is arguably one of the best footballers to pull on a Mitcham Jumper. Good experts say "certainly the best mark and kick". Goals win matches and Tony was clearly the League's most dominate full forward kicking 601 goals over 6 years at an average of 100 goals per season. He was clearly pivotal in the Club's dominance during his era at Mitcham.

To players and supporters alike, Tony 'Rocket' Andrews brought so much joy to the Mitcham faithful, like no other. He gave them immense hope and excitement as they witnessed the ball kicked long and high to Mitcham's goal square. Tony would 9 times out of 10, mark strongly (one grab) whilst a few opponents fell off him. He would go back, and kicked truly, often in poor ground conditions and from any angle. Tony's strength, size, and skill meant he could not be moved in a marking contest. Added to this his supreme judgement and towering ability to take one-grab marks and

kick goals. Rocket's kicking style was 'technically correct' leaving little room for error. This resulted in him being an extraordinarily accurate kick for goal, with an 85% successful conversion rate. Post his playing days Tony stepped up to give back to the Club, serving on committee as Treasurer and taking on many project roles. Tony's impact whilst at the Club was profound.
