Garry is a Mitcham boy, born in 1953. In 1966 Garry walked into the Club as a 12-year-old, playing in the Under 16's, proving to be a handy player (and team captain) at school and in junior football.

Predominately a Reserves player, Garry's strengths lay in the Club's off field needs, first working on the Senior Committee in 1977, while still a player. Garry had a lifetime of playing footy,

but his greater contribution and interest would see him focus on Club administration; in particular developing the Club facilities and improving the overall presentation of Walker Park. In addition, over time Garry became recognised as official Club Historian, a role he has held for several decades since the 1986. Garry's major achievements are many, but he will be forever acknowledged as the author of the Club's first 100 years' history (1888-1988) book: "Place Kicks to Drop Punts".
